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OVERVIEW

Afolabi Ghislain Agbede, PhD, is a Full Professor of Holistic Theology and African Urban Migratory Theology and a theological consultant; a researcher, curriculum designer, writer, author, teacher, leader, and visiting lecturer in various theological faculties. He supervises students and serves on Masters and Doctoral defence juries.

He is also a Research Fellow at the Centre for Faith and Community (Faculty of Theology) at the University of Pretoria (UP) in South Africa and a Research Fellow at the Department of Christian Spirituality, Church History and Missiology in the College of Human Sciences at the University of South Africa (UNISA) in Pretoria. He coordinates the Francophone part of Urban Africa 2050 research cohort (UP), focusing on Francophone African cities.
